

LETTER ON BEHALF OF ARCHBISHOP CHAPUT FROM OFFICE OF THE CLERGY

The Pennsylvania House of Representatives and Senate recently passed House Bill 800, which call for \$100 million increase (from \$110 million to \$210 million per year) in the Educational improvement Tax Credit (EITC). EITC allows businesses to take a write-off on their state taxes in exchange for donations to scholarship organizations. Needy students have used EITC funding to attend schools of their choice.

House Bill 800 has moved on to Governor Tom Wolf for consideration. Archbishop Chaput is urging people to contact the Governor this week to express support for the bill and to let him know the EITC program benefits the children and families of Pennsylvania.
