**Liturgy Committee:** plan religious services

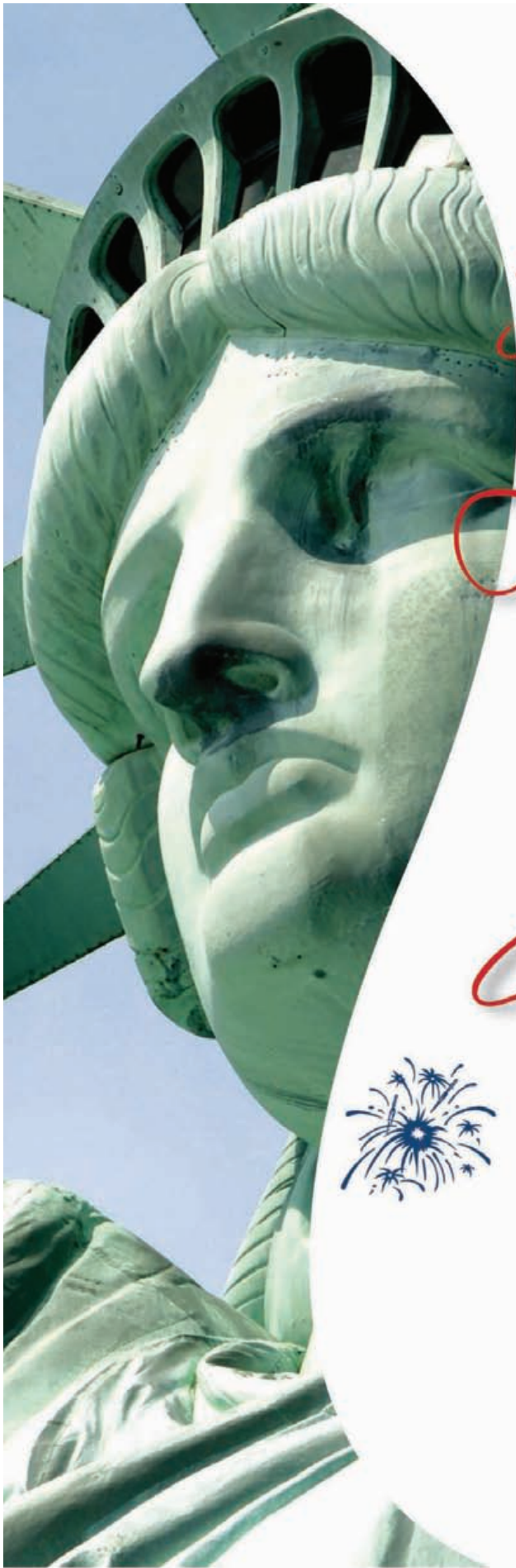
**Parish Pastoral Council:** meets several times per year to confer on Pastoral planning

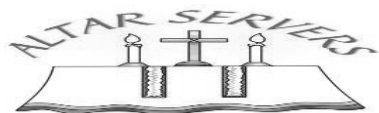
