


HOLY FAMILY COFFEE & CHARITY CLUB




The Women's Club next monthly bake sale will take place the weekend of March 9th and 10th after all the Masses in the rectory.






<u>ASHES</u> will be distributed on Wednesday, March 6th During the 8:00am and 7:00pm Masses.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Will be held beginning on Wednesday, March 13th at 7:00pm and every Wednesday thereafter during Lent followed by Benediction.



CONFESSIONS: Will be heard after Stations. It will be the same night.



The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligations, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all Fridays of Lent including Good Friday. Further, all those eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. These obligations are binding for meatless Friday and Ash Wednesday.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and receive the Holy Eucharist, to celebrate frequently in the Sacrament of Penance. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowel which has aided countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and our world.


