Liturgy Committee: plan religious services

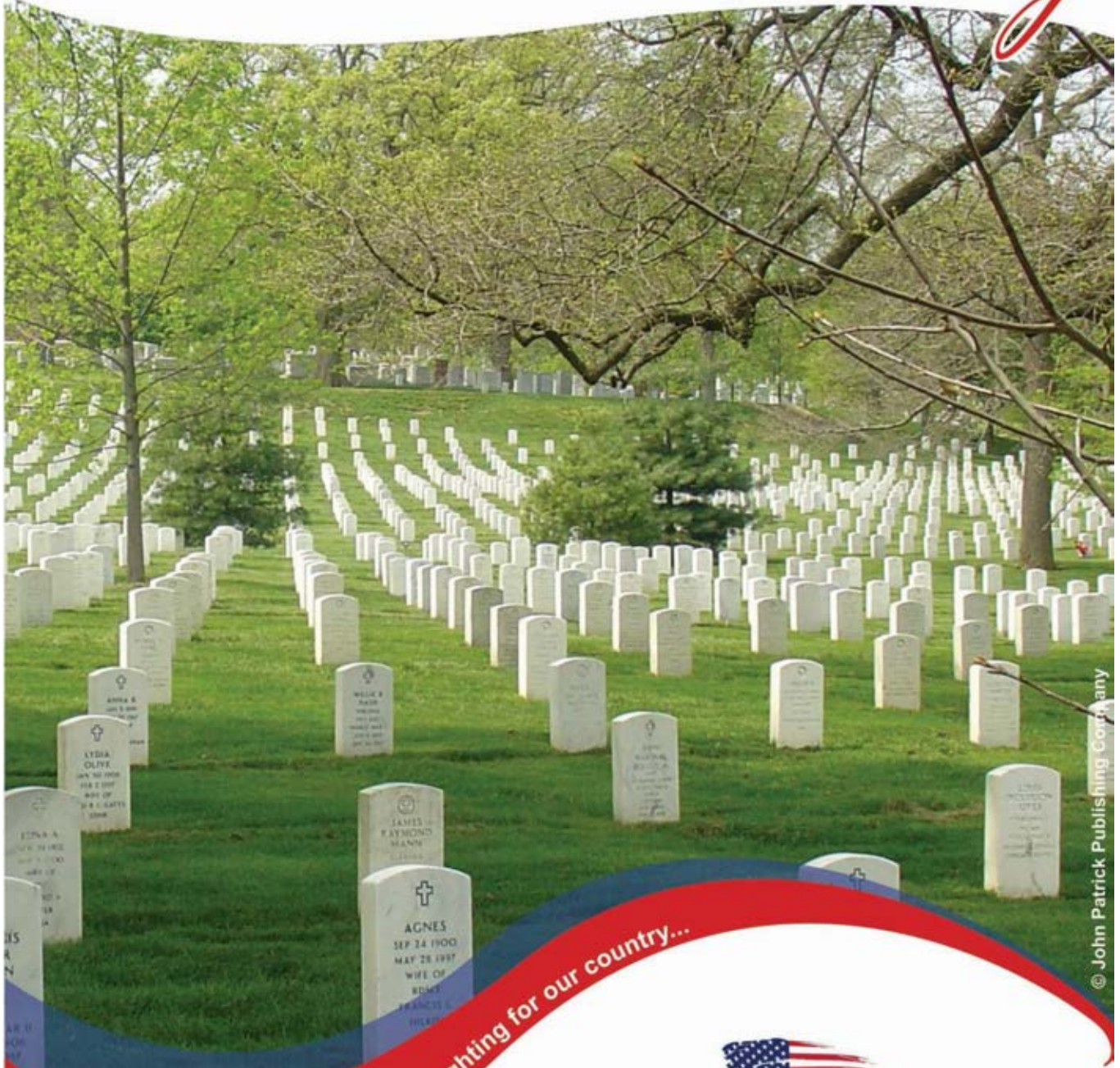
Parish Pastoral Council: meets several times per year to confer on Pastoral planning
