

September 15th, September 22nd, September 29th and October 6th. Confirmation candidates are expected to attend Mass every weekend and all Holy Days of Obligation.


IMPORTANT DATES AND INFORMATION

How do we respond in a loving way that is life-affirming for both her and her baby? First, prioritize listening over speaking. Ask her about her feelings, thoughts, values, beliefs, and wants. When her story is fully shared, it is your turn to provide factual information, in a loving and caring way. Encourage her.

Help her set goals that extend beyond her due date to help her see life beyond her pregnancy. Reassure her that she is not alone, and provide practical support. Pray with her, offering Christ's love at a crucial-life saving and life-defining moment.
