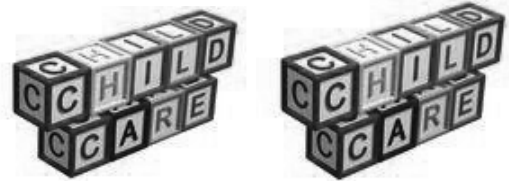

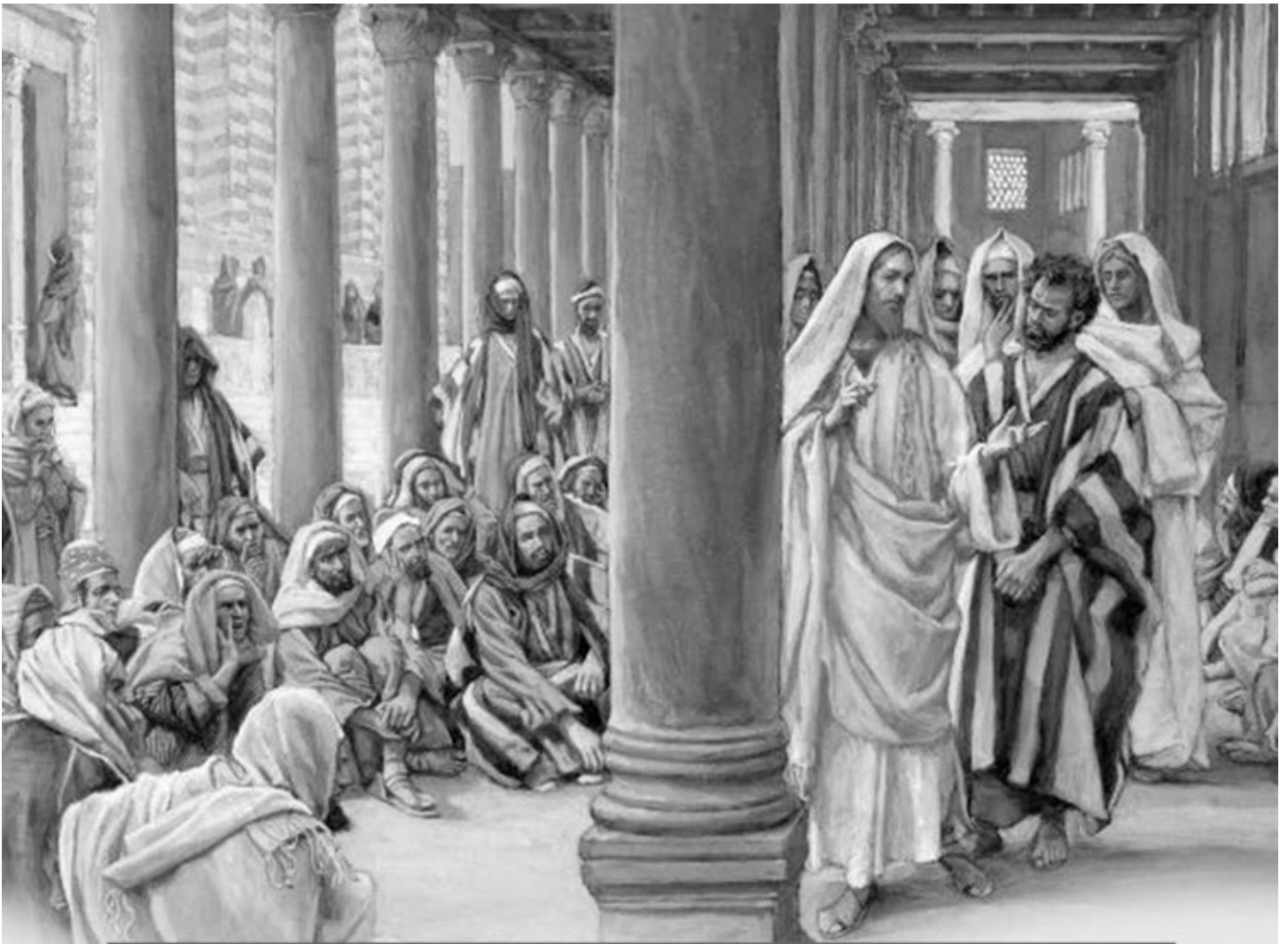
**HOUSEKEEPING**


