to our brothers and sisters in need.

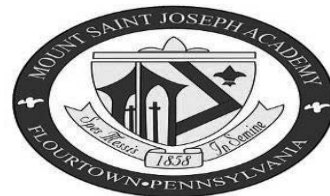

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.” The three-year Eucharistic Revival begins on June 19, 2022, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi.

SEVENTH ANNUAL PADRE PIO FESTIVAL ST. BEDE THE VENERABLE PARISH

Saint Bede the Venerable Church, located in Holland, PA. (Bucks County, Northampton Township), welcomes all to its Seventh Annual Festival to honor St. Pio of Pietrelcina, better known as “Padre Pio,” on Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 17 and 19. The two-day event begins with Saturday’s All-American Picnic Buffet (tickets sold at the event), featuring games and amusements for children, food and craft vendors, and live music. 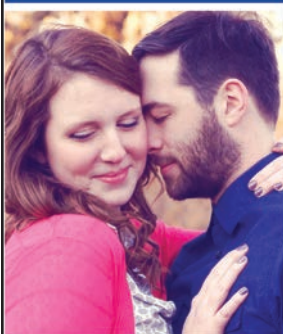
