#### ARCHDIOCESE OF PHILADELPHIA EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Corpus Christi, June 11, 2023 Launches the Parish Phase June 2023 -June 2024 "...the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world" John 6:51 In Archdiocese of Philadelphia, all parishes, institutions and religious communities are invited to launch the Parish Phase of the National Eucharistic Revival with a Solemn Celebration on the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) on Sunday June 11, 2023.

#### **CATECHESIS & INSTRUCTION**

Catechesis and Instructions for the celebration of Corpus Christi should begin with the first Sunday of May, May7, 2023. In addition to local resources, additional resources will be available on the archdiocesan website as of May, 2023. Begin to announce your plans for Corpus Christi May 2023.

#### SOLEMN CELEBRATION OF MASS

The Mass is the centerpiece of the observance of Corpus Christi. A solemn celebration of the Eucharist that includes every member of the community should be planned. Now is the time to form a planning group for the Mass and Procession for Corpus Christi.

#### **A EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION**

If possible, a Eucharistic Procession should be planned to follow the Solemn Mass. The ritual book, *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside* (Chapter 111.2) provides directives. If a Eucharistic Procession is not possible, then there should be a Holy Hour with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.


#### "BURRS AT THE BEACH"


