Dear Parishioners,

I would like to bring to you up to date on the status of the parish hall, which relates to the entire school. It has been a project of the Parish Pastoral Council to sell the under used school for over five years. We finally got an offer a year ago this August., but we are still waiting for a settlement date. In the meantime, we have developed maintenance problems with the roof of the school. The cost of the repairs is over \$200,000. We do not have savings to begin to cover any part of that expense. The building has not been used a school for a dozen years. No part of the structure can be used as of the latest rain storms for any purpose. We will have to make use of our other buildings, such as the Annex for meeting space. I wish that I didn't have to bring troubling news about the parish. Since we cannot fix the school, we have to sell it. The money from the sale will help pay our operating expenses. The parish strength depends upon the willingness of its parishioners to sacrifice, which you have done many times over and over.
