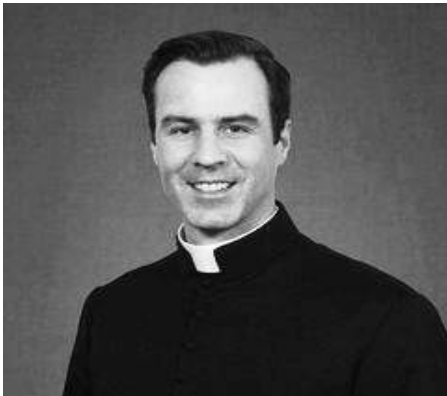

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Parishes throughout our local Church will soon take part in the national collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). Your support of this initiative creates impactful change in communities across the country and empowers those living in poverty to transform their lives.

One of the principles that has allowed CCHD to meet the needs of those living on the margins of society for more than 50 years is its support for community-based solutions to socioeconomic problems through the inclusion of local voices.

One example of that grassroots philosophy is the Eco-Cleaning Cooperative Franchise model began in 2018 by the Center for Family Life in Brooklyn. It was an entrepreneurial incubator designed to promote worker owner co-ops and community owned businesses. Locally, a similar venture launched in Philadelphia in 2022 as the South Philadelphia Cleaning Cooperative. Its core mission has been to provide a platform for businesses owned by underserved and minority individuals and to build a working environment grounded in safe conditions and just compensation. When these models are supported, they life and transform entire neighborhoods.

Your support of CCHD helps a diverse array of individuals facing hardships and provides grant funding for community initiatives like those described above. When you give to CCHD, 25% of your contribution stays in our local Church.
