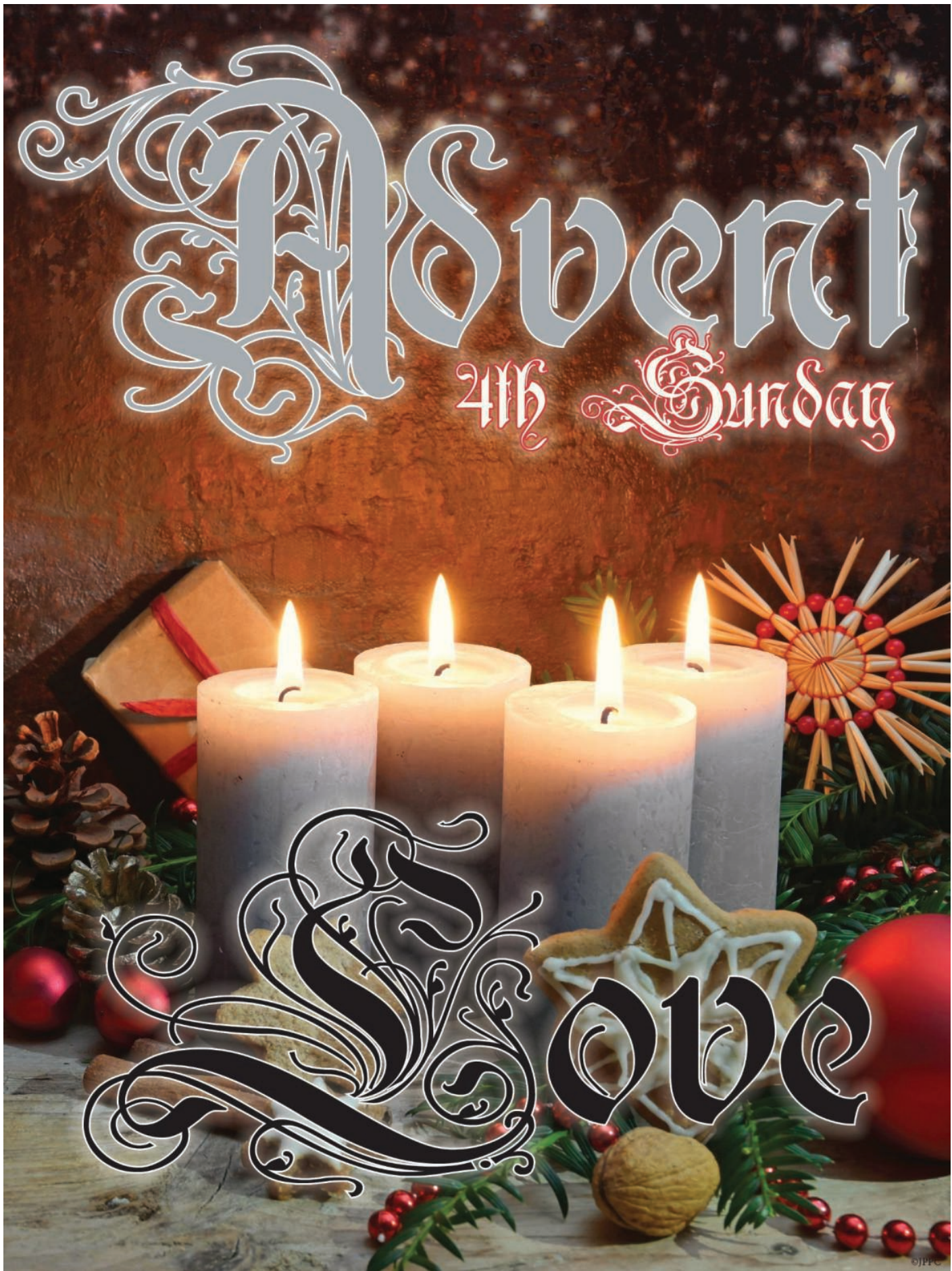

50/50 RAFFLE

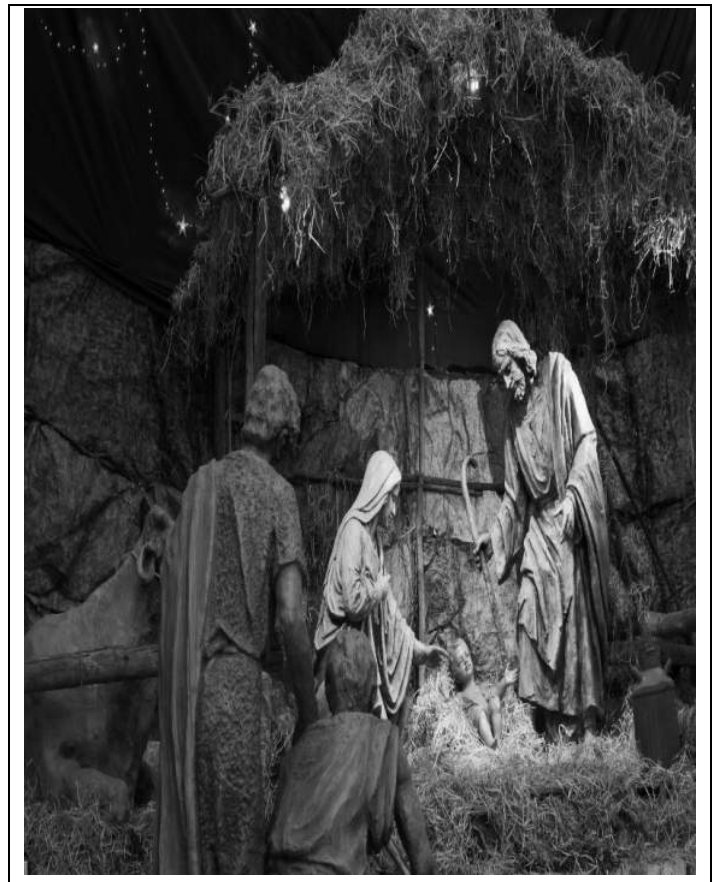

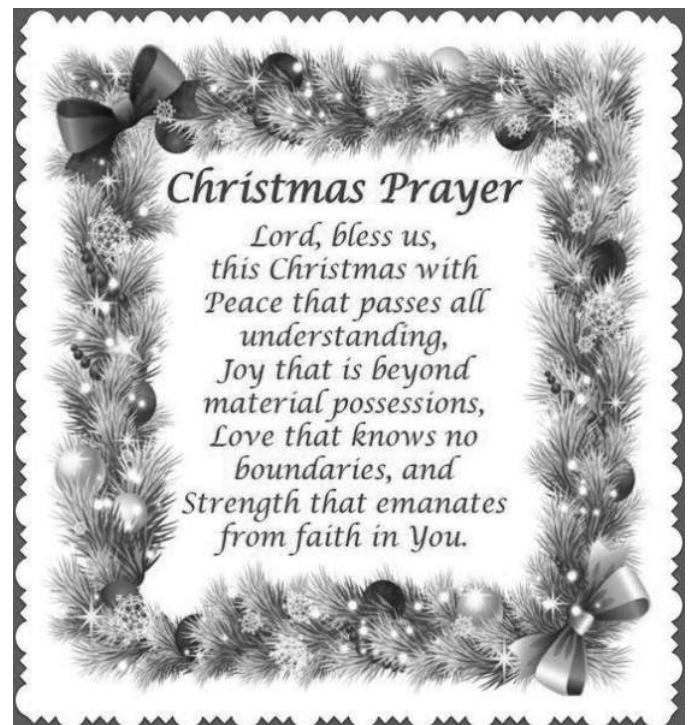

Dear Parishioner

Pope Francis wrote an Encyclical, He Loved Us, this past October to remind us of a devotion that we have had in the church for a long time. The means if Unity in the church is the love of the Sacred Heart for us, and our love of Jesus.

First, is the individualism versus the unity of community. It is about the love people, and not things in society.

Second, love must be professed in real practical ways of expressing our charity toward one another.

Third, there is no greater signal of the depth of feeling that comes from the heart, the seat of our emotional life.

Fourth, since the time of Saint Margaret Mary Alacque in the seventeenth century. Nothing is more symbolic than the wounded heart of Jesus on the cross of Good Friday. The blood and water from the pierced heart of Jesus is the sacramental life of the church. Christ was born to restore life to a fallen world.

Fifth, love and service are not just yearly practices, but the way we work for Justice and Mercy all year round. Hatred can lead to war death and destruction. Love is not law and order, but the way that leads to peace and justice. There will be no sense of community until conflict turns to love in every heart.
